## A Passion for Cooking: My Journey in the Kitchen

Hello, I'm Sherry Toy—the one who loves to cook for you! My journey began in April 2009 on Journey #72, and from that moment, I knew I wanted to be part of the cook team. However, before I could lead my own team, I had to cook alongside the men's team four times. They jokingly called me "Dryer Girl" because I had to do all the behind-the-scenes work before stepping into a leadership role. I quickly learned that knowing how to cook is one thing, but preparing nine meals in a row—on time—for 75 people is a whole different challenge! Thankfully, we now prepare eight meals instead, which makes weekend prep a little easier. Along the way, I also discovered the importance of good cooking tools and gadgets—so I always bring my own!

For each journey, I ask the Lay Director about their favorite foods and build a menu around their preferences. I've realized that while I can't please everyone, I can focus on delighting one person while ensuring everyone is well-fed. This time, however, things are a little different. Pam Gonzalez told me she likes everything—which, coincidentally, I do too! After working together on our last journey (and a little help from texting), I discovered her favorites. This weekend's menu will be a surprise to all, even Pam, featuring some of my personal recipes.

Over the past three years, I've also shared my love for cooking by teaching classes at a small shop in Brenham. Now, I'm expanding my passion by preparing to-go meals for friends each week. Cooking isn't just something I do—it's who I am, and I feel truly blessed to share this gift.



Message from Mary Gillis: Lay Director for Women's Journey #237
