## An Ecumenical Movement

The Journey to Damascus (JTD) was initiated as a Catholic sponsored spiritual renewal, whose aim is to promote leadership and service among Christian women and men from all faith backgrounds. Centered in the person of Jesus Christ, its goal is the promotion of mutual Christian values, partnership in promoting God's kingdom and servant leadership in church communities.

The Journey to Damascus is greatly supported and encouraged by members of the Methodist Emmaus, Episcopal Cursillo and Catholic Cursillo communities with the common goal being that we will all work together to make lives better.

During the weekend, there are 13 talks given by lay and clergy, touching upon God's gift of Grace, what it means to be disciples, and how we can make the changes in our lives that will bring us back to the path that God has chosen for us. This is done in an atmosphere of communal prayer and worship. Minds and hearts open up to the Holy Spirit. Small group activities foster a spirit of dialogue and mutual understanding. Hearts are touched, lives are changed. All builds up to strengthening the Body of Christ and to service and leadership in our various churches.



## What is a Journey Weekend?

The Journey to Damascus starts with a weekend that begins on a Thursday evening and ends Sunday afternoon. A program built around presentations and interspersed with periods of discussions, worship and meditation fills the time. Your weekend lasts only three days but you are invited to build on it for the rest of your life. After the weekend, those who have attended are encouraged to meet regularly in small groups that challenge and support one another. They build on what began during their weekend. The aim is to inspire, challenge and equip church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, workplaces and community.

## Who Should Attend?

The Journey is for Christians from all faith backgrounds who desire a firmer foundation for their lives and for fostering unity in Christ. It is not for theological debate or arguments about denominations. We gather together to renew and strengthen our faith and to build a community of God's children.
